

National Seed Day

Vasantdada Sugar Institute (VSI) celebrated the fourth 'National Seed Day' on 1st October 2018. On this occasion a one day training programme was conducted on 'Sugarcane Seed Multiplication and Production Technology' for Agriculture Assistants of sugar mills and seed nursery farmers. The event was co-sponsored by ICAR seed project.

Mr. SS Katake, Scientist, Farm Manager, welcomed the participants and guests of training programme. The event was inaugurated by Mr. Shivajirao Deshmukh, DG and Mr. Vikas Deshmukh, Director, Agricultural Sciences and Technology, Agriculture sectional Heads and Scientists were present. Total 127 trainees from 41 sugar mills were attended the programme. Mr. Vikas Deshmukh briefed about importance of threetier sugarcane seed system. He also stressed that improved cultivation techniques needs to be adopted for enhancing per unit cane and sugar productivity.

In the inaugural address Mr. Shivajirao Deshmukh opined that seed is most important inputs in sugarcane farming. Most of sugar mills and farmers are using same seed material year after year which resulted in declining productivity. He also highlighted the role played by VSI in production of breeder's seed. He stated that the role of sugar mills and their contribution in the seed replacement programme in the State is very low (6%) and pointed out that only 15-16 sugar mills are following the three-tier seed production program in Maharashtra state. It is most important to replace sugarcane seed once in threefour years. In view of this, Institute is raising breeders seed every year on 40 ha area for distribution to mills and very few mills are lifting seed as per their demand. Most of mills are unaware about the importance of seed replacement programme.

During technical session, Mr. RS Hapase, Principal Scientist and Head Plant Breeding Section had given lecture on 'Varietal scenario in the State, its Planning and identification', Mr. SS Katake, on 'Sugarcane cane seed multiplication & seed production technology'. Dr. SG Dalvi, Scientific Officer, Tissue Culture, on 'Sugarcane seed Production through Tissue Culture' and Mr. BH Pawar, Sr. Scientist & Head Plant Pathology and Mr. RG Yadav, Scientist & Head Entomology on 'Seed born diseases and control measures'.

Mr. RN Gaikwad, Scientific Officer had shown the demonstration of single eye bud seedlings production and seedling planting techniques. 

Field visit to Eco-restoration site Developed by Ecological Society at Panshet, Pune

One-day field visit organized for M.Sc. (Environmental Sciences) students by Department of Environmental Sciences for eco-restoration on 12th March 2019. Students were taken to the site at Panshet in Pune district which was ecologically restored by Ecological Society. 





involving various stakeholders from institutions, industry and Govt sectors. He informed about newly formulated state excise policy by GoM which is supporting EBP. Mr. Vivek Pittie mentioned about ethanol pricing formula need to put in public domain for increasing investor/sugar mill confidence. He also mentioned about ethanol blending need to be allowed more than 10% in surplus sugar state like Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra and Karnataka.

In concluding remarks, Mr. Shivajirao Deshmukh emphasized that distillery capacity is limiting factor in successful implementation of EBP and Gol should help sugar mills for increasing distillery capacity by providing financial & policy support. 
The 72nd Republic Day of India

National Seed Day

Vasantdada Sugar Institute (VSI) had organized Seventh National Seed Day on October 1, 2021 under the ICAR seed project. On this occasion a one day training programme was organized on 'Sugarcane seed multiplication & production technology' for Agriculture Assistants of sugar mills and seed nursery farmers.

This event was inaugurated by Mr. Sambhaii Kadupatil. Officer on Special Duty, in presence of sectional Heads of Agriculture Science and Technology Division. Mr. Kadupatil, in his inaugural speech, mentioned the importance of seed replacement in sugarcane. Sugarcane growers are using the same seed material year after year hence productivity is also declining. It is most important to replace sugarcane seed once in three-four years. Most of the mills are unaware of the importance of the seed replacement programme. Genetically and physically pure seed gives optimum germination due to which per unit yield increased by 10 to 15%. In view of this, Institute raising breeder's seed every year on 40 ha area for distribution to mills. During the program various lectures were given by scientists as follows; 'Varietal scenario in the State, its Planning and identification' by Dr. JM Repale,

Sr. Scientist, Plant Breeding Section, 'Sugarcane cane seed multiplication, production technology' by Mr. SS Katake, Scientist and Farm Manager, 'Sugarcane seed Production through Tissue Culture' by Dr. SG Dalvi, Scientist, Tissue Culture, 'Seed borne diseases and control measures' by Mr. BH Pawar, Sr. Scientist, Plant Pathology on and 'Integrated pest management' by Mr. RG Yadav, Scientist and Head Entomology section.

Mr. Shivajirao Deshmukh, Director General, VSI had discussed problems in the seed production in the concluding session and he mentioned that the seed replacement rate should be increased by more than 20%. Presently it is very less i.e. 6.0%. On this occasion message was given to participants to adopt improved seed production technologies and to replace old seed materials once in a three years.

For this National Seed day program total 86 trainees of 27 sugar mills have participated. The program was concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. RN Gaikwad, Scientific Officer, Farm Management and Development section.

The function concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. RV Dani, Technical Advisor & Head, Sugar Tech. Department, VSI.




