2.3 Project Objectives:

- To develop novel cavitation based and thermal pre-treatment of waste biomass resources, and enhance the yield of renewable chemicals, fuels and energy. <u>Focus</u> is on the design, scale-up and pilot or field scale trials for waste biomass such as distillery spent wash, bagasse, bagasse pith etc.
- 2) To develop new ways of pre-treatment, detoxification and biotransformation of pre-treated waste biomass to bio-CNG, salicylic acid, lactic acid and butanol. <u>Focus</u> is on unlocking synergy between pre-treatment, bio-transformation and process intensification to enhance economic viability.
- 3) To develop intensified and optimal pathways for value-added products from lignin and sugars derived from pre-treated biomass/ digestate from anaerobic digesters. Focus is on bio-CNG, SA, LA and butanol.
- 4) To carry out field scale trials of pre-treatment and develop modular processes and plants suitable for implementing in the sugar industries of India.
- 5) To train researchers, industries, local stake holders (farmers) and policy makers at all levels in the area of pre-treatment, biotransformations and life cycle analysis of valorizing waste biomass and process intensification/modular plants for sustainable production of renewable fuels and chemicals.
- 6) To develop approach, capabilities and know-how which will be generic and can be applied for addressing key global challenges and for making a tangible difference in many other developing countries

2.4 Project Duration:

The duration of the project is three years from the date of this Admin order.

4. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 4.1 A Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) will be signed between the Department of Biotechnology and the grantee institution on Non-Judicial stamp paper Rs. 100/- in the enclosed format and the second release/installment will be made only after signing of MoA by the grantee institutions and its acceptance by DBT. In case of NGO or Private Institution, MOA signed is mandatory first release. A format of the MoA is enclosed with:
 - a. Detailed project activities is placed at Annexure-I
 - b. Details of funds is placed at Annexure-II
 - c. The other terms and conditions governing this sanction is placed at Annexure-III
- 4.2 The Institute/Agency will keep the whole of the grant in a Bank Account earning interest, and the interest so earned should be reported to DBT in the Utilization Certificate and Statement of Expenditure. The Interest so earned will be treated as created to the institute/Agency and shall be adjusted towards further installment of the grant and or at the time of Final Settlement of Accounts.
- 4.3 No International Travel will be undertaken from the sanctioned project grant for the purpose other than the specified in the project.
- 4.4 The Director, Vasantdada Sugar Institute (VSI), Pune, Maharashtra; The Director, Indian Institute of Technology (IITB), Mumbai; The Director, Indian Institute of Technology (IITD), New Delhi and The Director, CSIR Indian Institute of Petroleum (CSIR-IIP), Dehradun would be responsible for submission of Statements of Expenditure (SoE), utilization certificates (UC), Assets Certificates, Manpower staffing & expenditure details in prescribed DBT formats to DBT in respect of grants released in this project from time to time.
- 4.5 PI's of DBT sponsored projects can consider appointment of JRF from Category-II merit list of DBT-BET exam so that candidates can be paid fellowships at par with NET/GATE/BET qualified candidates as per DST OM No. A.SR/S9/Z-09/2012 dated 21 Oct 2014. However, there is no compulsion on PI's to select candidates for JRF in their projects from Category-II of DBT-BET.
- 4.6 As per Rule 236 (1) of GFR 2017, the accounts of all Grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so.
- 4.7 In case the whole or a part of the amount of the grant-in-aid is being refunded, an interest thereon as per Govt, of India shall be recovered.
- 4.8 It is mandatory to acknowledge financial support provided by DBT via inclusion of Reference/ Grant number, Name of the Department (i.e. DBT) and the duration of the financial support including the dates in acknowledgement section of publications/patents/technology transfer documents vide notification no. DBT/PCAH/Gen/01 dated 7th June 2012.
- 4.9 It is obligatory to assess/observe the biosafety compliance for rDNA activities to be performed by institutions and investigators for the proposals submitted to DBT for financial support as per the notification vide no. BT/BS/17/459/2011-PID dated 26th September 2012.
